Camping rates:

50 Amp \$45.00 per night, single occupancy, plus \$10.00 per person per night
30 Amp \$35.00 per night, single occupancy, plus \$10.00 per person per night

Cabin rates:

1-4 \$100.00 per night, double occupancy

Annie Oakley and Belle Starr - primitive cabins

 \$60.00 per night double occupancy

Kasey Dutton and Valley View

 \$125.00 per night double occupancy

The one-time cleaning fees on Cabins are donated

Stalls: \$12.00 per night, per horse including shavings and firewood
